Making your own revision notes

Why make notes?

1. Making notes makes you **concentrate** on what you are learning.
2. Notes help you **understand** because you put ideas into your own words and diagrams.
3. Notes **link** new knowledge with what you already know.
4. Notes are vital for **revision**.
5. You **remember** things better when you have noted them down.

Clear and accurate abbreviations are used widely to save time and space when writing down notes.

Some students write notes with connecting words missing:
Save time + space, be careful when reading notes, interpret accurately.

Another way of abbreviating notes is to miss out the vowels:
Y cn still rd ths ltr y my nd sm vvls!

Think about where these abbreviations may be useful:

∴	therefore	<	less than
∵	because	>	greater than
*	same as above	=	equal
♂	male	≈	approx. equal
♀	female	≠	not equal
+ve	positive	NB	take note
-ve	negative	etc.	and so on
&	and	e.g.	for example

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
